We invite submissions for the fourteenth annual conference on the Political Economy of International Organization. The conference is hosted by Oxford University on January 13-15, 2022. The conference brings together economists and political scientists to address political economy issues related to international organizations such as the World Trade Organization, United Nations, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, European Union, and others. We also consider submissions on topics more broadly related to international organization, such as foreign aid, international agreements and international law.

#### **Submission of Papers**

Both empirical and theoretical papers will be considered. Please submit **full papers** via our online submission form at <a href="https://www.peio.me">www.peio.me</a>. The deadline for submission is **September 30, 2021**. We will make decisions by **October 31, 2021**.

#### Special Issue

After the conference, presenters are encouraged to submit their papers to the *Review of International Organizations* to be considered for a special issue "The Power of the Weak in International Organizations," coedited by Thomas Hale, Emily Jones, Karolina Milewicz, and Duncan Snidal (Oxford). Submission to the conference does not require submitting to the special issue.

### Conference Format, Attendance, and Registration

The number of participants will be limited to about 100 to allow for in-depth discussion of each paper. Authors of accepted papers are expected to attend the *entire* conference. There is no conference or registration fee. Travel and accommodation are at the expense of participants. Limited travel support will be provided, on application, to scholars from the Global South.

#### Conference Venue

The conference will be held at Oxford University in Oxford, United Kingdom. The closest airport is Heathrow (LHR), 60-90m by bus or train. Europe-based participants may wish to consider traveling by train via London, <60m by train.
