Political Economy of International Organization (PEIO)**

June 13-15, 2024 – Stockholm University, Stockholm

We invite submissions for the sixteenth annual conference on the Political Economy of International Organization. The conference is hosted by Stockholm University on June 13-15, 2024. The conference brings together economists and political scientists to address political economy issues related to international organizations such as the World Trade Organization, United Nations, International Monetary Fund, World Bank, European Union, and others. We also consider submissions on topics more broadly related to international organization, such as foreign aid, international agreements and international law.

### Submission of Papers

Both empirical and theoretical papers will be considered. Please submit **full papers** via our online submission form at [www.peio.me](http://www.peio.me). The deadline for submission is **January 15, 2024**. We will make decisions by **February 15**.

### Special Issue

After the conference, presenters are encouraged to submit their papers to the *Review of International Organizations* to be considered for a special issue titled “Public Opinion and International Organizations,” co-edited by Lisa Dellmuth and Jonas Tallberg (Stockholm University). Submission to the conference does not require submitting to the special issue.

### Conference Format, Attendance, and Registration

The number of participants will be limited to about 100 to allow for in-depth discussion of each paper. Authors of accepted papers are expected to attend the *entire* conference. There is no conference or registration fee. Travel and accommodation are at the expense of participants.

### Conference Venue

The conference will be held at Stockholm University, Stockholm, Sweden. Stockholm Arlanda Airport (ARN) is 20 minutes from downtown with Arlanda Express or 40 minutes by taxi. Conference hotels will be located in downtown Stockholm. The campus of Stockholm University is located three subway stops from the conference hotels.
